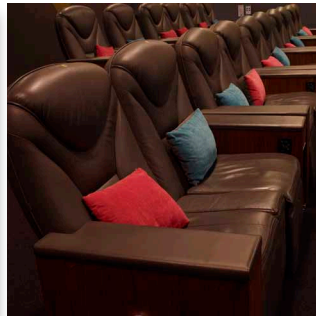

Venue Hire rates differ depending on the day and time of the booking; weekends are the most expensive time, followed by weekday evenings. At these times, our hire rates consist of the base hire for the venue, plus a minimum spend in the bar on food and beverage items. Bookings are for 2.5 hour sessions.

CHARITIES

The fee for these bookings is £700 (to screen a film we are already showing or if you own the rights to the film) or £800 (if you wish us to source a film) and the booking must be made at least two months in advance.

1. Bookings are subject to availability and may require distributor approval.
2. Bank holidays are charged at peak times.
3. All prices are inclusive of VAT.
4. External catering may incur a corkage fee.
5. Bookings that run over two different time sessions may incur additional charges.
6. Bookings that finish after midnight may incur additional costs.
7. If you are booking a 3D screening, a premium of £200 will be required.
8. Specific films requested that are not currently showing at the venue may incur a fee in addition to the private hire fee.
9. Operating hours may change during school holidays.
10. Cancellation charges may apply.

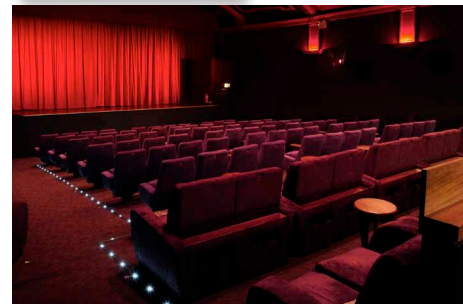

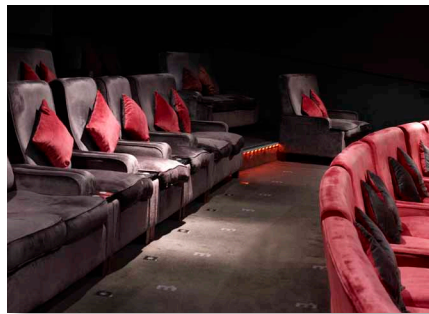

Screening Lounge 1

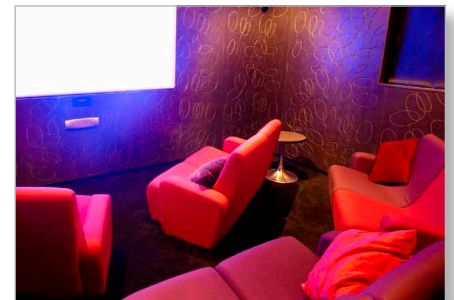

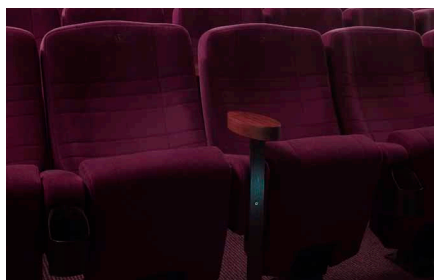
